## SEASONAL FACTORS FUEL STATE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE INCREASE FOR JANUARY 2006

- For the fourth straight month, Oklahoma's seasonally adjusted unemployment dropped, as seasonally adjusted employment grew. Since August 2005, unemployment has fallen by more than 9,100 people, while employment added almost 12,900 persons.
- The statewide non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for January 2006 was 4.4 percent, an increase of four-tenths of a percent from December. This behavior is typical, however, as this rate increase is seen each year at this time.
- This year's seasonal unemployment rate spike for the December-to-January period was smaller than normal, causing the **seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** to fall by three-tenths to 3.9 percent in January 2006.
