OKLAHOMA CITY, OK – In response Oklahoma City's General Motors plant closure, Workforce Oklahoma established the **Recruitment, Retraining and Re-employment Center** at 3921 S.E. 29<sup>th</sup> Street in Del City. This location, which is now open for business, provides workers who have lost their jobs with information and services to help them transition into new jobs or careers.

A variety of services are available at no cost to customers. Information is available on job markets, training, reemployment, and unemployment insurance. The Center's Resource Room provides access to computers, copiers, and fax machines. Services offered include job search assistance, Career Readiness certification, and linkage to community service agencies. Qualifying individuals may also receive tuition assistance, individual employment plan development, career counseling, and training. Additional partners will be added in the future to assist with social services that may be needed.

The **Recruitment**, **Retraining and Re-employment Center** is housed in a former medical building owned by Mid-Del Technology Center.
