## All Oklahoma county unemployment rates drop in August

In August, Oklahoma's nonseasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased by seven-tenths to 4.2 percent. **McCurtain County** again recorded the state's highest county rate, while **Beckham** and **Ellis** counties shared the lowest. All of Oklahoma's 77 counties reported over-the-month unemployment rate decreases, with **Coal County** providing the largest percent loss for the month.

## State unemployment rate slides to 4.2 percent for August

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** dropped by seven-tenths of a percent to 4.2 percent in August. All of the state's 77 counties followed suit, and no county reported a rate drop of less than 0.3 percent for the month. Among the regional states, only Texas matched Oklahoma's over-the-month unemployment rate improvement. The movement follows the trend seen for the United States as a whole.

In August, the Oklahoma counties with the three highest county unemployment rates were unchanged over the month. **McCurtain County** retained the top spot at 7.4 percent. **Coal County** was runner-up at 6.6 percent, and **Hughes County** was third at 6.5 percent. All of these rates dropped during the July-to-August period.


