# Most Oklahoma counties see unemployment rate improvement in September

In September, Oklahoma's nonseasonally adjusted unemployment rate dropped by one-tenth to 4.1 percent. **McCurtain County** once again reported the state's highest county rate, while **Beckham** and **Ellis** counties shared the lowest rate for the second straight month. **Sequoyah County** saw the largest

Sequoyah County saw the largest rate increase over the month, while four counties tied for the largest overthe-month rate drop of 0.5 percent.

### State unemployment rate slips to 4.1 percent in September

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** improved by 0.1 percent to 4.1 percent in September. Statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force** and **employment** recorded small gains, as **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** contracted over the month. September's unemployment rate is 0.3 percent higher than the rate reported for September 2006.


