County unemployment rates report movement in February despite relatively steady state numbers

Although the state unemployment rate held steady in February, there was movement among the rates for Oklahoma's 77 counties. **Sequoyah County** reported the state's highest rate and largest rate gain in February, and **Woodward County** claimed the state's lowest rate for the month. **Coal County**, the county with January's highest rate, reported the largest rate drop in February. The state unemployment rate of 4.4 percent is the same as the rate reported in February 2006.

State unemployment rate holds at 4.4 percent in February

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate held steady in February at 4.4 percent. Non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment all expanded slightly for the month, resulting in no change for the unemployment rate.

Sequoyah County wrestled the state's highest unemployment rate away from **Coal County** in February with a rate of 6.7 percent. This was an increase of 0.8 percent over the month, the largest month-to-month county increase reported for February. **Coal and Hughes counties** shared the month's second highest county rate of 6.5 percent. **Atoka and McCurtain counties** tied at 6.4 percent for Oklahoma's third highest rate in February.


