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OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - November 2007

Oklahoma's unemployment rate unchanged at 4.2 percent in November

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate held steady at 4.2 percent in November despite small increases in the state labor force, employment and unemployment. For the November-to-November period, Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose by 0.5 percent.

State employment continues to expand over month, year

- ➡ Oklahoma's statewide TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT added 5,600 jobs in November, following the same trend seen in eight of the past 10 years for the October-to-November period.
- Seasonal gains in Retail Trade helped drive growth in November. Statewide Retail Trade added 5,400 jobs, just 200 jobs short of the month's total growth in NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT.
- The Service Providing Industries contributed more than four of every five jobs gained in November despite a large seasonal loss in Leisure & Hospitality.

LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The statistics in this section are gathered from the **Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS)** program. LAUS produces labor force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rate estimates for the state and its subdivisions based on where workers live. Data is taken from a monthly household survey, and all LAUS numbers refer to individual persons rather than their jobs.

State unemployment rate unchanged at 4.2 percent in November

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** held steady at 4.2 percent for the month in November 2007. Statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force**, **employment** and **unemployment** all increased slightly over the month. Statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** grew by more than 15 percent between November 2006 and November 2007, resulting in an unemployment rate increase of 0.5 percent for the period.

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CURRENT EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The **Current Employment Statistics (CES)** program uses a monthly payroll survey of businesses to provide current non-farm establishment employment statistics. Non-farm employment is an estimate of employment by place of work. It does not include the self-employed, unpaid family members or agricultural workers. CES numbers refer to jobs instead of persons.

Seasonal factors impact state employment in November

Oklahoma employment added 5,600 jobs in November 2007, bringing the state's over-the-year gain to 23,000 jobs. Although all **Goods Producing Industries** reported growth for November, a majority of the monthly gain came from the **Service Providing Industries**, where seasonal hiring in **Retail Trade**, a division of **Trade**, **Transportation & Utilities**, overcame seasonal losses in **Leisure & Hospitality**.

No statewide industry reported any job losses for the year. Industries with sizeable over-the-year job growth included **Natural Resources & Mining, Construction, Professional & Business Services**, **Educational & Health Services**, and **Government**.
