# Oklahoma's unemployment rate up slightly in October

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** rose by 0.1 percent to 4.2 percent in October. The increase resulted from small additions to the non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment over the month.

## Statewide employment continues to expand over month

- ➡ Oklahoma's statewide TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT added 7,400 jobs in October, following the same pattern seen over the last five years for the September-to-October period.
- Educational & Health Services and Government combined to provide more than four of every five jobs gained in October.
- ⇒ The Service Providing Industries accounted for all but 200 of the jobs gained over the month in October.

#### LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The statistics in this section are gathered from the **Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS)** program. LAUS produces labor force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rate estimates for the state and its subdivisions based on where workers live. Data is taken from a monthly household survey, and all LAUS numbers refer to individual persons rather than their jobs.

### State unemployment rate rises to 4.2 percent for October

In October, Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** increased by 0.1 percent to 4.2 percent for the month. Statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force**, **employment** and **unemployment** all rose in October, leading to the unemployment rate gain. Over the year, statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** has grown by more than 15 percent, resulting in an unemployment rate increase of 0.8 percent for the October-to-October period.

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#### **CURRENT EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS**

The **Current Employment Statistics (CES)** program uses a monthly payroll survey of businesses to provide current non-farm establishment employment statistics. Non-farm employment is an estimate of employment by place of work. It does not include the self-employed, unpaid family members or agricultural workers. CES numbers refer to jobs instead of persons.

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# Seasonal education gains continue to fuel state job growth in October

Oklahoma employment added jobs again in October, gaining 7,400 over the month. The monthly increase came from the **Service Providing Industries**. For the year, Oklahoma's **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** grew by 21,900 jobs.

Like in September, growth in **Government** and **Educational & Health Services**, driven by seasonal education factors, accounted for more than 85 percent of the monthly expansion. For the October-to-October period, **Natural Resources & Mining, Construction, Professional & Business Services, Educational & Health Services, Leisure & Hospitality, and <b>Government** all reported large over-the-year gains.
