Most Oklahoma unemployment rates on the rise in May

In May 2007, Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted state unemployment rate increased by 0.7 percent to 4.5 percent. Of the state's 77 counties, only **Dewey** and **Harmon counties** reported unemployment rate drops for the month. **Coal County** again reported the state's highest county rate, while **Major County** recorded the state's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.8 percent.

Statewide unemployment rate up to 4.5 percent in May

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** rose to 4.5 percent in May. This increase reflects losses in the state's **non-seasonally adjusted labor force** and **non-seasonally adjusted employment** combined with a major spike in **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** over the month. This movement is in line with the trend seen each year during the April-to-May period. Over the year, **non-seasonally adjusted labor force**, **employment** and **unemployment** all reported gains.

Coal County claims state's highest county rate in May

In May, **Coal County** again reported the state's highest county unemployment rate at 7.2 percent, an overthe-month increase of 1.0 percent. **McCurtain County** claimed the month's second highest county rate of 7.0 percent, and **Sequoyah County** held sole possession of the third highest rate of 6.7 percent. These rates represented monthly increases of 1.3 percent and 1.2 percent, respectively.



There was a five-way tie at 3.0 percent for the May's third lowest county rate among **Beaver**, **Dewey**, **Kingfisher**, **Murray** and **Woodward counties**.
