OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - June 2007

State unemployment rate up to 4.7 percent in June

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** crept up to 4.7 percent in June, representing an over-themonth increase of 0.2 percent. This movement falls in line with the trend seen each year during the May-to-June period.

Oklahoma sheds jobs over the month in June

- ➡ For the first time since January, statewide TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT dropped jobs over the month. This loss, however, was seasonal in nature and followed the May-to-June trend seen each year.
- ➡ Educational & Health Services and Government provided a majority of June's monthly loss, reflecting the start of summer break for public schools and universities.
- Natural Resources & Mining continues to post strong year-to-year growth. In June, the industry reported an over-theyear gain of 4,600 jobs.

LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The statistics in this section are gathered from the **Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS)** program. LAUS produces labor force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rate estimates for the state and its subdivisions based on where workers live. Data is taken from a monthly household survey, and all LAUS numbers refer to individual persons rather than their jobs.

Statewide unemployment rate up to 4.7 percent in June

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate climbed to 4.7 percent in June. Although the state's non-seasonally adjusted labor force and non-seasonally adjusted employment both expanded over the month, non-seasonally adjusted unemployment grew more than three times as fast. This resulted in the rate's over-the-month increase of two-tenths of a percent. Over the year, non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment all reported gains in June.

All information contained within this document is available free of charge on the OESC website (www.oesc.state.ok.us/lmi/) and through LMI publications developed by the ER&A division. <u>Unless otherwise noted</u>, <u>all statistics are preliminary and have not been adjusted for seasonal factors</u>. All data is collected under strict guidelines provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics. Although a large amount of data has been presented, this in no way suggests that all data has been included. Due to space restrictions, only relevant industries and sectors are included for each geographic area.

CURRENT EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The **Current Employment Statistics (CES)** program uses a monthly payroll survey of businesses to provide current non-farm establishment employment statistics. Non-farm employment is an estimate of employment by place of work. It does not include the self-employed, unpaid family members or agricultural workers. CES numbers refer to jobs instead of persons.

Oklahoma employment drops jobs over month for first time since January

Oklahoma employment growth ground to a halt in June 2007, as the state's **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** dropped 4,900 jobs over the month. This movement follows the trend of May-to-June job losses that started in 1998. Over the year, Oklahoma's **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** continued to expand with an addition of 19,000 jobs.

All of the monthly loss came from the **Service Providing Industries**, where seasonal education declines impacted **Educational & Health Services** and **Government**. Although many Oklahoma industries contributed to the over-the-year gains, **Natural Resources & Mining** and **Government** combined to provide nearly two-thirds of the annual growth recorded in June.

Despite monthly losses, Tulsa MSA continues annual growth in June

Monthly losses were driven for the most part by seasonal education factors, as public schools and universities started summer break.

Most Tulsa industries contributed to the over-the-year gain of 4,600 jobs, with **Trade, Transportation & Utilities** and **Professional & Business Services** providing the largest number of jobs. The **Information** and **Financial Activities** sectors each reported a significant over-the-year loss for June.
