Unemployment rates up for many Oklahoma counties in October

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose by one-tenth to 4.2 percent in October. Two-thirds of the state's counties followed suit and reported rate increases for the month. **McCurtain County** again reported the state's highest county rate, while **Beckham County** claimed the lowest rate. **Cimarron County** saw the largest rate increase, while **Sequoyah County** provided the largest over-the-month rate drop of 0.9 percent.

State unemployment rate rises to 4.2 percent for October

In October, Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** increased by 0.1 percent to 4.2 percent for the month. Statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force**, **employment** and **unemployment** all rose in October, leading to the unemployment rate gain. Over the year, statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** has grown by more than 15 percent, resulting in an unemployment rate increase of 0.6 percent for the October-to-October period.


