### February unemployment rates down in all Oklahoma counties

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 3.5 percent in February 2008. **Sequoyah County** claimed the state's highest county rate, while **Beaver and Beckham counties** shared the lowest rate. Unemployment rates were down in all 77 of Oklahoma's counties, with **McCurtain County** reporting the largest over-the-month rate drop of 1.9 percent.

### State unemployment rate drops in February

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased by 0.7 percent in February 2008 to 3.5 percent. Statewide non-seasonally adjusted labor force, non-seasonally adjusted employment, and non-seasonally adjusted unemployment were all down over the month. Statewide non-seasonally adjusted unemployment dropped by more than 18.0 percent over the month and more than 25.0 percent over the year.


