Many Oklahoma counties see little change in November unemployment rates

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained at 4.2 percent in November. **McCurtain County** again reported the state's highest county rate, while **Beckham** and **Woodward counties** shared the lowest rate. **Sequoyah County** reported the largest rate increase, and **Alfalfa County** provided the largest over-the-month rate drop.

State unemployment rate unchanged at 4.2 percent in November

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate held steady at 4.2 percent in November 2007. Statewide non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment all increased slightly over the month. Statewide non-seasonally adjusted unemployment grew by more than 15 percent between November 2006 and November 2007, resulting in an unemployment rate increase of 0.5 percent for the period.


