Oklahoma's statewide unemployment rate up again in June

In June, Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** increased to 4.2 percent. For the June-to-June period, the statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** dropped by 0.4 percent.

State job count down in June despite gains in both MSAs

- Oklahoma's statewide TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT shed 1,000 jobs (-0.1 percent) in June. The loss resulted mostly from seasonal education factors affecting Government over the month.
- ➡ Government shed 6,200 jobs (-1.9 percent) in June. The loss reflected public schools and universities going to summer schedules. This type of loss is seen each year at this time.
- The largest monthly addition in June was provided by Construction. This industry expanded by 2,500 jobs (+3.4 percent) for the month.

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LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The statistics in this section are gathered from the **Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS)** program. LAUS produces labor force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rate estimates for the state and its subdivisions based on where workers live. Data is taken from a monthly household survey, and all LAUS numbers refer to individual persons rather than their jobs.

June brings statewide increases in labor force, employment and unemployment

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate expanded in June 2008, increasing by 0.7 percent to 4.2 percent for the month. Statewide non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment all expanded over the month, but it was unemployment's 19.6 percent gain that drove June's unemployment rate increase. Since June 2007, statewide non-seasonally adjusted unemployment has dropped by more than 8.0 percent.

CURRENT EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The **Current Employment Statistics (CES)** program uses a monthly payroll survey of businesses to provide current non-farm establishment employment statistics. Non-farm employment is an estimate of employment by place of work. It does not include the self-employed, unpaid family members or agricultural workers. CES numbers refer to jobs instead of persons.

Oklahoma's statewide employment down in June

Oklahoma **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** reversed course in June 2008 and contracted by 1,000 jobs over the month. Losses came from the **Service Providing Industries**, led by a 6,200-job drop in **Government**. Other **Service Providing Industries** that shed jobs for the month were **Information** (-100 jobs), **Educational & Health Services** (-100 jobs), **Leisure & Hospitality** (-100 jobs), and **Other Services** (-200 jobs). The month's largest employment increase came from the **Construction** industry.

Over the year, statewide employment added 21,900 jobs. The only industry that failed to add jobs during this period was **Other Services**.

Monthly growth was held in check by seasonal losses in **Government**. The MSA's largest monthly gain came from the **Construction** industry.

For the June-to-June period, the Oklahoma City MSA grew by 9,300 jobs. The big annual gainers for June were **Educational & Health Services** and **Leisure & Hospitality**. Industries reporting job losses for the year included **Manufacturing**, **Information**, **Financial Activities** and **Government**.
