## Unemployment rates down in many Oklahoma counties for July

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 4.0 percent in July 2008. As in June, **McCurtain County** claimed the state's highest county unemployment rate, while **Beaver and Woodward counties** shared the lowest county rate. More than two-thirds of Oklahoma's 77 counties reported an unemployment rate decrease for the month.

# July brings over-the-month drops in statewide labor force, employment and unemployment

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** slipped to 4.0 percent in July, improving by 0.2 percent for the month. Although statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force**, **employment** and **unemployment** all contracted over the month, it was **unemployment's** 3.7 percent loss that fueled July's unemployment rate shift. Since July 2007, statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** has contracted by 5,200 persons.

### McCurtain County reports highest county rate in July

In July, **McCurtain County** claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate for the month again at 7.4 percent. **Hughes County** claimed the state's second highest rate, and **Sequoyah County** rounded out the three highest county unemployment rates at 5.8 percent.


