## Unemployment rates up for most Oklahoma counties in October

Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 4.1 percent in October 2008. McCurtain County recorded the state's highest county unemployment rate again, and Beaver, Ellis and Roger Mills counties shared the lowest county rate. Of the state's 77 counties, 73 reported rate increases for the month. Payne and Sequoyah counties were the only counties to see rate drops in October.

## Statewide unemployment up big in October

In October 2008, Oklahoma's non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate rose by 0.6 percent to 4.1 percent for the month. Although Oklahoma's statewide non-seasonally adjusted labor force, employment and unemployment all expanded over the month, it was the 18.6 percent increase in non-seasonally adjusted unemployment that drove the rate expansion. Compared to October 2007, statewide non-seasonally adjusted unemployment has grown by more than 1,000 persons, while non-seasonally adjusted labor force and employment have each increased by more than 35,000 persons.


