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# Introduction

## Description of Data

This publication contains average annual employment and payroll figures for the state and each county for the calendar year 2003. In addition, covered employment and average weekly earnings figures are included by major industry division for every county in the state and the Oklahoma City, Tulsa, Lawton, and Enid Metropolitan Statistical Areas. The information contained in this handbook was tabulated from the quarterly contributions reports and Multiple Work-site Report supplements submitted by employers subject to the *Oklahoma Employment Security Act*.

## Covered Employment

Covered employment is the number of workers employed by employers subject to the *Oklahoma Employment Security Act* during the monthly payroll period, which includes the 12th day of the month. Effective January 1, 1978, several previously excluded segments of the work force were brought under coverage of the *Act*. Briefly, coverage was extended to include most employees of all political subdivisions including elementary and secondary schools. Also added were agricultural employers with a payroll of \$20,000 in any calendar quarter, or with ten or more employees in any 20 weeks of a calendar year. At the same time, domestic service employers with a payroll of \$1,000 in any calendar quarter were added.

Effective in 1972, firms with one to three employees in 20 calendar weeks of a year or \$1,500 in payroll became subject to the *Act*. For the period of 1956 through 1971, employers were subject to coverage when they had four or more employees in each of 20 different calendar weeks within one year. Prior to 1956 required coverage included those firms with eight or more employees in 20 weeks.

The largest groups of employees not covered include the self-employed and federal government employees. Beginning with the 1991 edition of the Oklahoma County Employment and Wage Data book, federal employment has been included in the tables and calculations. Including federal employment provides a more complete picture of economic activity in the state, although this affects the comparability of this data with previous editions.

## Average Annual Employment

The average annual employment figures shown for each year in this publication are the arithmetic means of the 12 monthly figures. Because these figures are rounded to the nearest whole number, the sum of the industry division may not add up to the average for a county. Also, the sum of the county averages will not necessarily add up to the state average for the same reason.

## **Total Wages**

The annual total wage figures and the average weekly wages used in this publication include all wages and salaries paid to federal and covered employees including bonuses, commissions and cash value of all remuneration received in any medium other than cash. These wages include both taxable and non-taxable wages.

## **Average Weekly Wages**

The average weekly wages shown were computed by dividing the total wages for the year by the average employment to arrive at an annual average wages rate. This rate, in turn, was divided by 52 weeks to determine average weekly wages.

## **Industrial Divisions**

Employment and wages are reported by major industry division as defined in the 1997 edition of the *North American Industry Classification System Manual*. Industry detail shown in this handbook covers the following industry divisions:

Industry division employment in this issue differs from previous issues. Previously, private sector employment was classified in one of nine industry divisions while all Government employment was counted in Public Administration or Federal Government. Beginning in this issue Government employment will be classified with private sector employment in the appropriate industrial division. The only employment counted in the Government division will be those Government jobs that are not classifiable in one of the nine industry divisions.

## **Multiple Work-site Employment**

Beginning in 1991 the federal government, in cooperation with the individual state employment security agencies began soliciting work-site level employment and wage data from employers with more than one permanent physical work-site. Previously, most of these employers had been aggregating and reporting work-site level employment and wage figures from their payroll reports at the county level. This procedure proved burdensome for many employers and increased the possibility of errors being included in the calculations. The revised reporting procedure involves quarterly reports of employment and wages at the work-site level submitted in Multiple "Work-site Reports" with work-site address information pre-printed on the form. The goal of the revised procedure is to coordinate work-site employment and wage reporting. This will provide the public, state government and the Bureau of Labor Statistics with more detailed information. The comparability of data with previous editions may be affected as a result of revised procedures and increased detail.
