The Tulsa Local Labor Market (LLM), located in northeastern Oklahoma, covers Creek, Osage, Pawnee and Tulsa counties.

During second quarter 2011, Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC) employees at the Tulsa Skyline Workforce Center served more than 4,000 customers with services including work registration, assessments, profiling, and job search workshops. The Tulsa Skyline Workforce Center has assisted 684 customers with job search workshops to help with interviewing and applications.

The **Center** also administers state merit exams for the Oklahoma Office of Personnel Management. Applicants for many state jobs must complete this testing to be considered for the position. This quarter, **Center** staff administered 136 of these tests.

SPOTLIGHT ON

WORK OPPORTUNITY TAX CREDIT

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) program provides tax incentives to employers who hire from targeted groups that traditionally face significant barriers to employment. Depending on the certified target group to which a new hire belongs, an employer can receive a tax credit of \$2,400, \$4,800 or \$9,000 for each WOTC-eligible worker hired. Groups targeted by WOTC include recipients of Temporary Assistance to Needy Family (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) food stamps, Supplement Security Income (SSI), long-term family assistance, and vocational rehabilitation as well as summer youth employees, designated community residents, ex-felons, disabled veterans, unemployed veterans and disconnected youth. Most workers who don't qualify for the maximum tax credit can receive a partial credit. There is no limit to the number of workers for whom an employer can claim the tax credit.
