## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - January 2009

### Oklahoma's unemployment rate continues to rise in 2009

Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** rose to 5.6 percent in January 2009, an increase of 0.8 percent for the month. January's statewide rate was 1.8 percent higher than the rate reported for January 2008.

### Job count down for state, MSAs in January 2009

- In January, Oklahoma's statewide **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** contracted by 31,800 jobs (-2.0 percent). Losses were seen across all statewide supersectors, except **Financial Activities**, which reported no change for the month.
- The largest over-the-month drop came from **Government** (-8,500 jobs), where losses in **State Government** drove the monthly change.
- Over the year, **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** grew by 6,300 jobs (+0.4 percent). Large gains were reported in **Construction, Leisure & Hospitality**, and **Government**. **Manufacturing** reported the largest over-the-year loss (-7,800 jobs) in January.

LAUS produces labor force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rate estimates for the state and its subdivisions based on where workers live. Data is taken from a monthly household survey, and all LAUS numbers refer to individual persons rather than their jobs.

## State unemployment continues to expand for January 2009

In January 2009, Oklahoma's **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate** rose by 0.8 percent to 5.6 percent for the month. Oklahoma's statewide **non-seasonally adjusted labor force** and **employment** reported losses for the month, while **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** grew by 15.0 percent. Compared to January 2008, statewide **non-seasonally adjusted unemployment** rose by 47.5 percent, or 31,240 persons.

# CURRENT EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The **Current Employment Statistics (CES)** program uses a monthly payroll survey of businesses to provide current non-farm establishment employment statistics. Non-farm employment is an estimate of employment by place of work. It does not include the self-employed, unpaid family members or agricultural workers. CES numbers refer to jobs instead of persons.

## Statewide employment continues to decline in January

Oklahoma **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** shed 31,800 jobs, or about 2.0 percent, over the month. Losses came from both the **Good Producing Industries** and the **Service Providing Industries**. For the January-to-January period, **TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** increased by 6,300 jobs, most of which came from the **Service Providing Industries**.

- All statewide supersectors contracted in January, except for **Financial Activities**, which reported no change for the month.
- The largest monthly loss came from **Government**, where **State Government** contributed a 7,100-job loss.
- The 7,100-job drop in **Trade, Transportation & Utilities** was driven by **Retail Trade**. This loss follows the pattern seen each year in **Retail Trade** for the December-to-January period as temporary workers hired for the holiday shopping season are let go.
- **Educational & Health Services** shed 600 jobs in January, despite the fact that the **Health Care & Social Assistance** sector grew by 600 jobs over the month.
- Most of **Leisure & Hospitality's** 1,900-job loss came from the **Accommodation & Food Service** sector.
- The largest over-the-year loss came from **Manufacturing** (-7,800 jobs).
- **Construction** reported a 2,000-job increase for the year.
- The largest annual gain of 4,900 jobs was shared between **Leisure & Hospitality** and **Government**.

## Oklahoma City MSA drops jobs in January

**TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** in the Oklahoma City metropolitan statistical area (MSA) shed 7,900 jobs in January 2009 as most supersectors contracted for the month. Over the year, the Oklahoma City MSA expanded by 7,000 jobs due to large gains in some supersectors overcoming smaller losses in others.

- **Financial Activities** (+100 jobs) was the only supersector to add jobs for the month.
- When combined, **Professional & Business Services** and **Government** accounted for more than half of the jobs lost in January.
- **Trade, Transportation & Utilities (TTU)** shed 1,400 jobs in January due mostly to seasonal losses in **Retail Trade** (-1,200 jobs).
- **State Government** (-1,200 jobs) helped drive the **Government** supersector to a monthly loss of 1,900 jobs.
- Large gains for the year were reported in **Mining & Logging**, **Educational & Health Services**, **Leisure & Hospitality**, and **Government**.
- **Food Services & Drinking Places** provided much of **Leisure & Hospitality's** 2,300-job over-the-year increase.
- **State Government** also helped drive annual growth in **Government** for January.

## Tulsa MSA employment contracts in January 2009

**TOTAL NON-FARM EMPLOYMENT** in the Tulsa metropolitan statistical area (MSA) dropped 9,200 jobs in January. Over the year, the Tulsa MSA expanded by 3,000 jobs, with the only large loss coming from **Professional & Business Services**.

- When combined, **Trade, Transportation & Utilities; Professional & Business Services; and Government** accounted for nearly 80 percent of all job losses for the Tulsa MSA in January.
- **TTU** shed 3,600 jobs over the month. A majority of this loss came from **Retail Trade**.
- All of **Government's** 1,600-job monthly loss came from **State Government**.
- **TTU, Educational & Health Services, Leisure & Hospitality, and Government** each reported an annual gain of at least 1,000 jobs for January 2009.
- Most of **Government's** 1,800-job annual loss in January was provided by **Local Government**.
